## INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the school is Runcorn All Saints Church of England Primary School.
2. The school is a voluntary aided school.
3. The name of the Governing Body is "The Governing Body of Runcorn All Saints Church of England Primary School".
4. The Governing Body shall consist of:
  - a) 2 Parent Governors
  - b) 1 LA Governor
  - c) 1 Staff Governor
  - d) 1 Head Teacher
  - e) 7 Foundation Governors
5. Total number of governors 12.
6. Foundation Governors, other than the ex-officio Foundation Governor, shall be appointed as follows:

6 governors by the Chester Diocesan Board of Education in consultation with the Parochial Church Council of All Saints Church Runcorn.
7.
  - a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio:

The principal officiating minister in the parish of All Saints Runcorn
  - b) The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio Foundation Governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that that ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a Foundation Governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.
8. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall be entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio Foundation Governor and to appoint any substitute governor.

9. There is a trust for the school.
10. Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its Christian character in accordance with the principles of the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of the Christian faith and promotes these values through the experience it offers all its pupils.

11. This instrument of government comes into effect on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2015.
12. This instrument was made by order of Halton Local Authority on 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2015.
13. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the Head Teacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the appropriate religious body.
